

4837/1930 (A' 252) "On the Amendment and Supplementation of Law No. 2456/1920 on Jewish Communities"

Article 1

Article 3 of Law No. 2456 is hereby amended as follows:

Members of the Jewish Community shall, by operation of all, be all persons of the Jewish religion who permanently reside within the seat of the Community.

Article 2

Article 6 of Law No. 2456 is hereby amended as follows:

"Each Jewish Community shall be administered by the Community Council elected from among the members of the Community Assembly who have attained the age of twenty-five (25) years.

The Community Council shall be composed of Greek citizens and shall have its seat in each Community. It shall administer the property and, in general, all affairs of the Community, and shall further oversee, through the charitable and educational institutions and other pious foundations, the pursuit of its religious, charitable and educational purposes".

Article 3

At the end of article 9 of the aforementioned Law, the following shall be added:

Those who, prior to the entry into force of the present Law, bore the title of Chief Rabbi but had not complied with the formalities prescribed by this article and by the special regulations approved pursuant to article 17 of Law No. 2456 concerning the statute of each Community, shall cease to hold such office, retaining only the title and position of Rabbi.

The Chief Rabbi and the Rabbis must possess Greek nationality.

Article 4

Article 16 of the aforementioned Law is hereby amended as follows:

"The supreme authority of each Community, before which the Chief Rabbi and the Community Council shall be accountable, shall be the Community Assembly.

The Community Assembly of each Community shall be composed of representatives, all of whom shall be Greek citizens, the number thereof being determined by the internal regulations of each Community, and elected by all male members of the Community who have attained the age of twenty-one (21) years.

Any provision contrary to the present Law is hereby repealed. This Law shall enter into force upon its publication in the Government Gazette.

The present Law, having been passed by the Chamber of Deputies and the Senate and issued by the king this day, shall be published in the Government Gazette and shall be executed as a Law of the State.
