

**Ministerial Decision No. 5832/02/18-01-2022 “Classification of the taught subjects (subject groups) in the Medresses of Thrace” (B’ 135/19-01-2022)**

1. The subjects taught in the Lower Secondary School (Gymnasium) of the Medresses of Thrace are classified into three groups, as follows:

Group A: 1) Modern Greek Language and Literature (Language Instruction and Modern Greek Literature), 2) Ancient Greek Language and Literature (Ancient Greek Language and Ancient Greek Texts in Translation), 3) History, 4) Mathematics, 5) Physics, 6) Biology, 7) English, 8) Quran, 9) Fiqh (Interpretation of Islamic Law) for the 1st and 2nd grades of Gymnasium, and Quran and Aqidah (Fundamental Principles of Islam) for the 3rd grade of Gymnasium, which are examined in the written promotion or graduation examinations.

Group B: 1) Geology – Geography, 2) Chemistry, 3) Social and Civic Education, 4) Technology – Computer Science, 5) Home Economics, 6) Arabic Language, 7) Turkish Language, 8) Islamic History, 9) Sīra.

Group C: 1) Music – Arts, 2) Physical Education, 3) Skills workshops.

The timetable of the Medresses of Thrace determines which of the above subjects are included in each grade of the Gymnasium.

2. The subjects taught in the Upper Secondary School (Lyceum) of the Medresses of Thrace are classified into two groups, as follows:

For the 1st Grade of Lyceum

Group A: Subjects of General Education and Islamic Religious Specialization that are examined in written form in the exams: 1) Greek Language (Ancient Greek Language and Literature and Modern Greek Language and Literature), 2) Mathematics (Algebra and Geometry), 3) History, 4) Science (Physics and Chemistry), 5) English, 6) Quran, 7) Fiqh (Interpretation of Islamic Law).

Group B: The remaining subjects of General Education and the subjects of Islamic Religious Specialization (i.e. other than those in Group A), which are not examined in written form in the exams.

For the 2nd Grade of Lyceum

Group A: Subjects of General Education and Islamic Religious Specialization that are examined in written form in the exams: 1) Greek Language (Modern Greek Language and Literature), 2) History, 3) Science (Biology), 4) Mathematics (Algebra and Geometry), 5) English, 6) Quran, 7) Fiqh (Interpretation of Islamic Law), 8) Subjects of Orientation Groups.

Group B: The remaining subjects of General Education and the remaining subjects of Islamic Religious Specialization (i.e. other than those in Group A), which are not examined in written form in the exams.

For the 3rd Grade of Lyceum

Group A: Subjects of General Education and Islamic Religious Specialization that are examined in written form in the final exams: 1) Modern Greek Language and Literature, 2) Mathematics (only for students of the Humanities Orientation Group), 3) History (only for students of the Science and Health Studies Orientation Group and the Economics and Computer Studies Orientation Group), 4) Quran, 5) Al-Imamah (Practical Duties of the Imam), 6) all subjects of the Orientation Groups.

Group B: The remaining subjects of General Education and, among the subjects of Islamic Religious Specialization, all remaining subjects (i.e. other than those in Group A), which are not examined in written form in the final exams.

In all other respects, the provisions of Presidential Decree 126/2016 (A' 211) and Ministerial Decision No. 102474/Δ2/20.8.2021 (B' 4134) shall apply, with the clarification that the actions assigned therein to the Principals shall be exercised jointly with the Vice-principals of the Medresses of Thrace.

Upon the publication of the present decision, Ministerial Decision No. 8966/Θ2/26.1.2021 (B' 333) shall cease to be in force.

This decision shall be published in the Government Gazette.
